

Final Report to EDCUtah Special Project Match Grant

Project Overview

On December 5, 2024, San Juan County hosted its third annual Business Basecamp Conference & Expo at the USU Blanding Campus Arts & Events Center. The event brought together more than 120 attendees, including business owners, nonprofit leaders, tribal representatives, and partners from local, state, and federal agencies. It was a full day focused on sharing tools, building connections, and generating ideas to strengthen our local economy.

Use of EDCUtah Funds

The \$5,000 grant from EDCUtah was used to bring in Deb Brown, co-founder of SaveYour.Town, as our keynote speaker. Deb is well known for her work helping small towns take practical steps toward revitalization. Her keynote, "Unlocking Rural Potential with the Idea-Friendly Method," introduced a people-first approach to creating change—focused on gathering your crowd, building connections, and taking small steps.

Each attendee received a copy of her book, and Deb stayed after her talk for a book signing and deeper conversations with participants. Her talk was a highlight of the day and set the tone for collaborative, community-focused discussion.



What Happened as a Result

The real impact was in the shift in mindset. Many attendees left feeling empowered to act on ideas they've had for years. Conversations sparked around local placemaking, community-led projects, and how to move forward with limited resources.


As a direct result:

- Plans are now in motion for mural and art projects in Blanding and Monticello

- Small group discussions helped attendees reconnect with why they do this work—and how they can contribute in tangible ways
